Boating Without Owning

Q. How do I know boats will be available?

A. The Club maintains a boat to Member ratio that preserves the availability of the boats. Our reservation policy allows all Members equal access to reservations. A Member has the ability to have four reservations scheduled at any given time and can reserve up to six months in advance.

Q. How hard is it to get boat reservations on the weekends?

A. We recommend making reservations for weekend days 1 to 2 weeks in advance in the Summer, 2-3 days in the Spring and Fall. We strongly suggest taking advantage of our 6-month advance reservations policy for special events such as birthdays, anniversaries, etc.

Q. What if I have no boating experience?

A. You will need to have a state issued safe boating certificate. Members then attend one classroom session followed by "On the Water" training with one of our USCG licensed captains. Training covers CBC processes, general navigation, docking, and safety.

Q. Is insurance included?

A. Yes! In the unfortunate case of an accident our members are only liable for up to the insurance deductible (\$2500.00). Members also have the option of buying the deductible down to as little as \$500.00

Q. What are the cruising limits?

A. Limits are 25 miles East to 25 miles West, if you would like to visit Manhattan or points further east, you can hire one of our licensed captains to run the boat for you.

Q. When do the boats have to be back at the docks? Can I take them overnight?

A. Our normal business hours are 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. April through October (weather/ light permitting). If you wish to stay out later than 8pm, you simply need to request permission (You need to have 40 hours of incident free operation in order for us to determine your skill level). Once you have taken the boat out until dusk a few times and successfully docked and tied up without assistance, you are then permitted to use the boats overnight. All boats need to be at a dock and tied up by sunset.

Q. May I join with my friend/partner/sibling/parent/etc?

A. A member can add another secondary member on his account who must also be trained/licensed. You would be the responsible party and must make reservations for them. All fuel use or damage would be billed to the primary member.

Q. How do I reserve a boat?

A. We have an online reservation system, ResNet, that you can reserve a boat 24 hours a day up to 6 months prior to when you want to go out. Members may also boat "Spur of the Moment" by speaking with our dock staff directly and reserving a boat.

Q. How old must a member be?

A. Any member must be at least 25 years old.
